

## CASE STUDY #2

A 91 year-old female; HTN, COPD, dementia; bedfast

Patient is a new admission who presented with multiple pressure wounds.

**6/9/2009**

Site #1: Right Trochanter: Stage IV 4.8 x 3.0 x 0.6  
About 75% necrotic tissue, 25% granulation tissue  
Dress with Santyl and gauze QD

Site #2: Right Iliac: Stage IV 6.4 x 3.2 x 0.4  
About 50% necrotic tissue, 50% granulation tissue  
Dress with Santyl and gauze QD



**7/23/2009**

Site #1: Right Trochanter: Stage IV 4.2 x 3.4 x 0.7  
About 25% necrotic tissue, 75% granulation tissue  
Dress with Santyl and gauze QD

Site #2: Right Iliac: Stage III 1.5 x 0.5 x 0.2  
About 25% yellow slough, 75% granulation tissue  
Dress with Santyl and gauze QD



**2/11/2010**

Site #1: Right Trochanter: Stage IV 0.8 x 0.5 x 0.5  
About 5% yellow slough, 95% granulation tissue  
Dress with Santyl and gauze QD

Site #2: Right Iliac: HEALED  
Dress with Vitamin A & D and gauze QD
